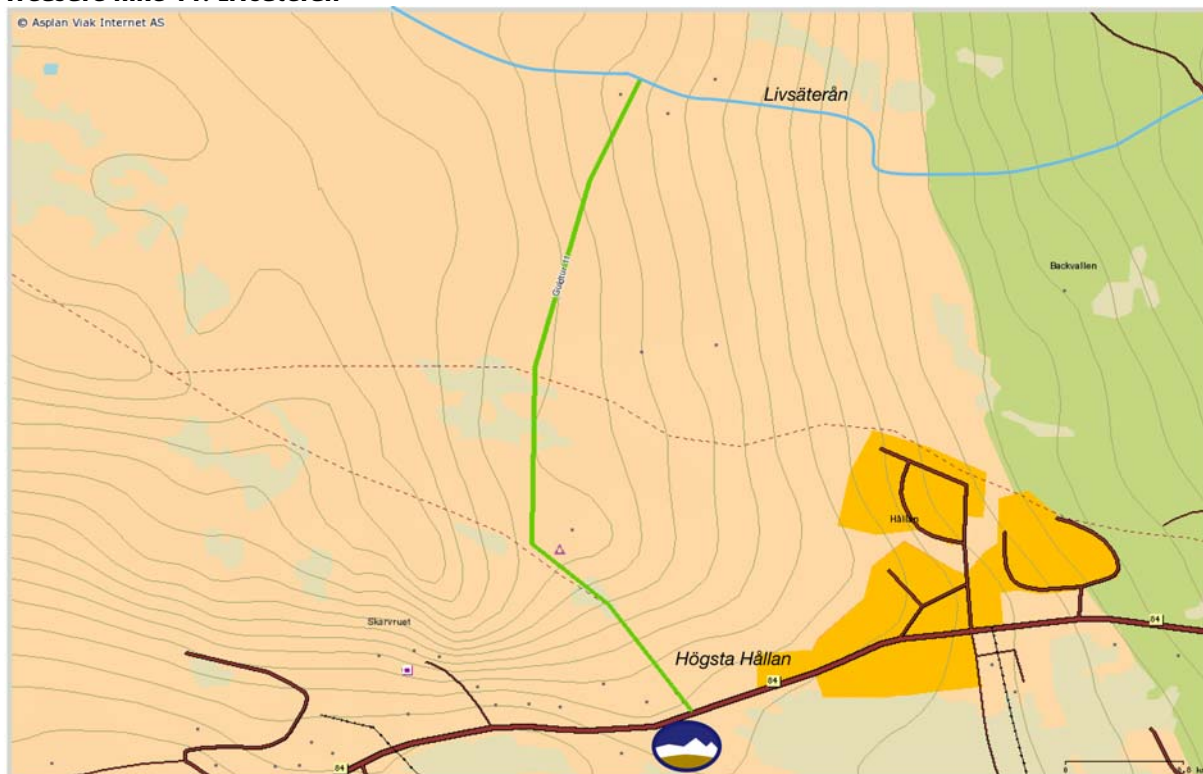


Treasure hike 11: Livsäterån



An easy and pleasant hike up to Flåten and Livsäterån with a vertical variation of ca 80 metres; scenic views and waterfalls.

Follow the marked trail on the north side of the road leading up to Malmbäcksstugan and Lill-Skarven. Pass the Nordic Ski tracks (the fine cross-country skiing tracks of Funäsdalen) and continue another few hundred metres.

As the trail turns left, continue the path straight ahead, past a large rock. The path is somewhat harder to see as you come out on the bogs after the hill, but try to keep a relatively straight course and you will reach a larger path after the wetlands a few hundred metres onwards. The path becomes obvious in the form of an old road as the trail coming from the right passes a small brook. Follow this path straight ahead towards north, until the River Livsäterån appears in a ravine. The river cuts deeply into the rock and there are several flat slabs for a picnic. You can also have a dip in the small pretty waterfalls. Great views over Funäsdalen village and Mount Funäsberget.

Return by the same way.
